1. Call to Order, Roll Call and Establishment of a Quorum: Uwe Gsedl, Adrianna Sarellana, Heidi Kuharich, Sara Phalen, Buddy Plumlee, and Anni Holm in attendance, meeting called to order at 7:06.
2. Approve Meeting Minutes of June 6, 2019, July 11, 2019, August 29, 2019
 - a. Approval of June 6, 2019 Minutes: Anni made a motion to approve, Adrianna seconded, all in favor
 - b. Approval of July 11, 2019 Minutes: Adrianna made a motion to approve, Buddy seconded, all in favor
 - c. Approval of August 29, 2019 Minutes: Uwe made a motion to approve, Heidi seconded, all in favor
3. Update on Mural Dedication & Silent Auction for Butterflies: ballet folklorico will perform two different dances-one from Michoacán and hopefully one from Chiapas, speaker system-look into one-could use PMV one if City does not have one; mariachi will only perform if it is above 50 degrees-play the ceremony in, place in middle, place the ceremony; need to determine if Tampico will be painting the wall; Buddy is going to put another coat on the mural Saturday; who is designing a program?-Rosemary?; no reason to have refreshments but Anni will ask Rosemary if perhaps Tampico is putting out any fruit; John from Signarama will install mural on Tuesday

Silent Auction for Butterflies: credit card payments can be run through Gallery 200 but there is a 3% fee, what should the bidding start at? Have butterflies leaned against the wall and then tape the auction sheet above-pencils to fill out ;Uwe will send Rosemary pictures for bid sheets

Are we doing this again next year? Butterflies and bees-pollinators? Wrap electrical boxes, paint fire hydrants; make it bi-annual art throughout town paired with a different type of public art on the off year
4. Judges for Art Banner Exhibit – Home: possibly Ryan Hammer, he has been asked and will get back to us with his final answer
5. Annual Review of Maintenance Needs for Existing Public Art: Anni is okay with how it looks now and is comfortable with us delaying any reprinting for another year-check again in the fall of 2020 to see if it has gotten worse and perhaps we know more about the life of the building; need to pay for Buddy's plaque and rust from the wheel is running down on the mosaic, but Buddy is comfortable to let it weather as it will; also okay with letting the lilies wear further; we will look at lighting additions for loveevenmore as a maintenance cost
6. Library Proposal on Landscape & Lighting for loveevenmore: we will test lighting; gravel or ground covering low cut moss that is different than the grass to further delineate

7. Other Business:

Sara has asked if someone else would like to takeover secretary duties as he work schedule has gotten very busy, Heidi made a motion to appoint Adrianna as the new secretary with Sara's resignation from that position, Anni seconded, all in favor passed
